Proceedings and the Resolutions

The following are the proceedings and the decisions taken during the IQAC meeting:

- 1) Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 31 October 2019 was presented by the IQAC coordinator and it was confirmed unanimously.
- 2) Being the last meeting of the IQAC for the academic year, the Convener presented the action taken report of IQAC for the academic year 2019-20 and it was appreciated by all.
 - a) IQAC initiated and facilitated organisation of teaching and learning for higher education in social work, mass relations and disaster management by admitting 248 students in regular programmes and 219 students in distant education programmes
 - b) IQAC facilitated to establish and strengthen collaborating with at least 63 development organizations and communities for field work and extension
 - c) IQAC initiated conducting of students' study tours for exposure to innovative development works in the state (Akole) and out of state (Lucknow, Kochi, Kottayam and Goa).
 - d) IQAC initiated and facilitated to engage students in voluntary work and social service through NSS programme
 - e) IQAC initiated and facilitated to organise 10 workshops, trainings and seminars for building competencies of students and the faculty members

- f) IQAC initiated and facilitated to organise and undertake 5 research and extension projects with the support from industries, government agencies and NGO's
- g) IQAC facilitated organisation of 12 student development programmes and support services
- h) IQAC facilitated celebration of 20 important days of the academic year 2019-20 such as, Savitribai Phule Jayanti, Teachers' Day, National Youth Day, World Literacy Day, Girl Child Day (India), Alzheimer's Day, etc. in order to imbibe nationalism, compassion and sensitivity among the students
- i) IQAC facilitated participation and paper / poster presentation of students in International and national level conferences and seminars held at Kochi, Kottayam, Lucknow and Goa
- j) IQAC initiated and facilitated organisation of youth festival to give opportunity for students to nurture their talents and increase their social sensitivity and encouraged them to participate in University and state level competitions
- k) IQAC facilitated student exchange program of 08 Students and 01 faculty from Colorado State University (CSU) from United State in July – August 2019
- l) IQAC facilitated faculty members for participating in various faculty development programmes like refresher courses, seminars etc. Three faculty members completed their UGC refresher courses and four faculty members attended International and national seminars, presented papers and served as resource persons
- m) IQAC initiated and facilitated hosting of Fulbright Scholar, Prof. Pallassana Balgopal, Professor Emeritus, Illinois University, USA during 23rd November 2019 to 18th January 2020 to conduct faculty development programme
- n) IQAC facilitated maintaining smooth functioning of the organisation and efficient and transparent governance by frequent meetings with faculty, students and other stakeholders. Altogether 4 IQAC meetings and 20 meetings with other stakeholders such as faculty members, administrative staff, students and alumni were conducted during the academic year 2019-20.
- o) IQAC facilitated to mobilise and network with alumni and parents for development of Institute.
- p) IQAC facilitated to maintain the eco friendly and divyang friendly campus
- q) IQAC initiated to respond to the disasters and innovate ways and means to provide relief to them
 - i) Organized one month relief and rehabilitation works in 4 flood hit villages of the Shirol block of Kolhapur district (Bastwad, Herwad, Danwad and Khidrapur) in February-March 2020
 - ii) During the lock down IQAC has initiated a centre providing free shelter, food and medicine for the migrant workers stranded in Ahmednagar district.
